\$8,000 – van/bus replacement (dedicated for this purpose only)

\$1,000 – Jason & Kate Faircloth/GEM

\$1,000 – Midway Middle School Bible Club

\$1,800 – Computer and software for church office

\$5,744.17 – Hurricane Flood victims

Any left over money from the above shall be added to the Flood Victims donation.
