## ***“MODELING”***

When we think of modeling, we may think of beautiful girls walking down the runway. Every step they take says look at me. Take notice of my hair, my clothing, my fashion. Christian modeling isn't completely different. It is you and I setting ourselves apart and calling on others to check us out. Look at how we act. Listen to what we say. Observe how we live.

Recently we have witnessed three ladies, Tammy, Carlee and Carlie, place their trust in Christ. They will be baptized on Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. As these ladies are baptized, they are setting examples themselves, worthy of imitating. Have any of you committed to following Jesus, but never followed through with baptism? What they are doing is a witness and a reminder to you. And like our Lord said, “Come and follow me.” Lead on dear ladies. And know that you are ever more beautiful than any runway model.
